

UPDATE TO LOUISIANA BEHAVIOR ANALYST BOARD
EMERGENCY PLAN – COVID -19

The Louisiana State Police Fingerprinting Division is closed from March 20 - April 13, 2020.

Line technician applicants who check no to any arrests will be processed immediately with the agreement that a background check will be initiated within three working (3) days of the reopening of the LSP office which is currently scheduled for April 13, 2020.

Failure to complete the initiation of the background check within three working (3) days of the reopening of the LSP office will result in revocation for one (1) year.

Any CBC results that show an application was falsified will result in the registration being immediately revoked for one (1) year as opposed to three (3) months.

The compliance officer will work with any applicants who must check yes to prior arrests in an attempt to register, if possible. The first duty is to protect the public so this may not be possible with all applicants due to the severity of the charge (s) and/or how recent.

If any local entities are still fingerprinting, applicants are expected to mail their completed paperwork, fingerprint cards and processing fee to LBAB with their application. LBAB will forward to LSP for processing.
